#### **Nomination and Voting Dates:**

Nominations for Wap Mayor and Queen must be received by **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> March**. Nominations for Princesses and Flag Boys will also be needed by **Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> March**, although late nominations may be accepted if numbers permit as these are non-elected

### **Nomination criteria:**

For a nomination to be valid the nominee must meet the criteria listed on the back page and be proposed by a signatory of the Poll Book, the form must be countersigned by the nominee (or parent / carer)
